I RESTORED THE CORNER THROUGH ACCEPTANCE OF OBLITERATED EVIDENCE LOCATION. THE ROAD RECORDS CALL FOR THE SECTION LINE AS THE CENTER OF THE R/W. I USED THE CENTER OF THE PAVEMENT TO CONTROL THE E/W LOCATION. THE 1958 AIR PHOTOS SHOW A ROAD GOING TO THE WEST. THE PRESENT E/W FENCE LINE AND LARGE OAK TREE TO THE NORTH INDICATES THAT THE ROAD WAS A 3 ROD ROAD. I USED THE CENTER OF THIS TO CONTROL THE N/S DIRECTION. THE DISTANCE TO THE E 1/4 CORNER OF
