CORNERS SHALL BE REFERENCED WITH AT LEAST 4 DURABLE WITNESS MONUMENTS. WITNESS MONUMENTS SHALL BE MADE OF CONCRETE, METAL, STONE, IRON OR OTHER EQUALLY DURABLE MATERIAL EXCEPT WOOD. DESCRIBE THE CORNER AND THE WITNESS MONUMENTS.
