330 ENTER TURTLE RIVER BOTTOM BEARS NE & SW

2640 SET A RED ELM POST 6" DIAMETER AND 4' LONG 2' FEET IN THE GROUND FOR QUARTER SECTION CORNER. THE GROUND FROZEN. I CANNOT RAISE A MOUND AND I CANNOT GET A STONE, AND THERE ARE NO TREES WITHIN A HALF A MILE. LAND THE BOTTOM IS MOSTLY DRY RICH SOIL FIT FOR CULTIVATION. THE BLUFF BOTTOM IS ABOUT 40 FEET HIGH BUT NOT STONE IN THE BANKS.
