

THE SOUTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THAT SW 1/4 IS A TRIANGULAR
POINTED LIMESTONE 15X14X12. HE DOES NOT STATE THE DISTANCE
TO THE SECTION CORNERS. HE SHOWS THE SECTION LINE AND
NORTH/SOUTH DISTANCES TO VARIOUS POINTS ON THE MAP.

HOLMES SUBDIVISION "HOPKINS ADDITION" BK 4 PG 48. CALLS FOR STONE MONUMENT, S4-16E 676.8' TO IRON BOLT IN CENTER OF MERRILL ST & BLUFF ST, CORNER IS 33 EAST OF WEST ROW LINE OF BLUFF ST, S85-10W 658.65 TO IRON PIPE AT THE CENTER OF LIBERTY ST & OAK ST, & BEARINGS ARE MAGNETIC COURSES WITH A VARIATION 4-17E.

1890 WILSON "ADAMS SUBDIVISION OF BLOCK 5" BK 5 PG 14. HE STATES THAT MERRILS ADDITION WAS STAKED WITH A CHAIN 6 INCHES TOO LONG. CALLS FOR A 33.25 RIGHT OF WAY ON BLUFF AND A 33.25 RIGHT OF WAY ON LIBERTY AVE.

HOLMES'S "PEET AND SALMON'S" SUBDIVISION BOOK 5 PG 15.
STATES THAT THE POINT OF BEGINNING IS S1-15W 340.56 FROM THE SECTION CORNER. THE BEARING AND DISTANCE TO A COMPUTED POSITION IS S1-40-00W 339.35. HE ALSO STATES THE DISTANCE AND BEARING FROM A LOT CORNER ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF LAWTON FROM A STONE MONUMENT AT THE INTERSECTION OF LAWTON AVENUE AND THE NORTH LINE OF SECTION 36 IS S52-23W 196.35. THE DISTANCE FROM A FOUND PIPE TO THIS COMPUTED POSITION IS S56-55-38W 197.48.

HIS MAP WHICH WAS FILED IN THE BELOIT CITY ENGINEER'S

HE SHOWS NORTH/SOUTH DISTANCES FROM THE SECTION LINE TO
VARIOUS MONUMENTS. HIS MAP CALLS FOR A DISTANCE OF 2641.82
FROM THE EAST QUARTER CORNER TO THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF
SECTION 26. HE ALSO CALLS FOR AN ANGLE OF 90-12-30 AT THE
SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SECTION. I COMPUTED AN ANGLE OF 9014-39. HIS MAP ALSO SHOWS THAT THE CORNER IS IN A
BUILDING. THE COMPUTED DISTANCE FROM THE WEST QUARTER
CORNER TO THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 25 IS 2631.29. BATTERMAN
CALLS FOR A DISTANCE OF 2631.85. THE ANGLE NW CORNER-W 1/4
CORNER-SW CORNER OF SECTION 25 IS 179-59-54. THIS ANGLE IS

TO THE RIGHT.

I DID NOT FIND THE CORNER. I DETERMINED THE POSITION OF THE CORNER FROM THE LOT CORNERS IN THE ADJACENT SUBDIVISION PLATS. THIS WAS ALSO IN HARMONY WITH THE CENTER OF THE N/S & E/W PAVEMENT. I DID NOT INSTALL A MONUMENT BECAUSE THE ROAD WILL BE REBUILT.
