C) Was the corner restored through acceptance of (1) an obliterated evidence location, or, (2) a found perpetuated location?

I DID NOT FIND A RECORD FOR THE PLACEMENT OF THE CIMONUMENT. THE 1975 WPL ANGLE @ THE NW COR SEC 29 FROM THE N 1 4 COR SEC 29 TO THE W 1 4 COR SEC 29 IS 90-38-44. MY ANGLE IS 90-38-46. SINCE THE ANGLE DIFFERENCE IS ONLY 2" AND MY DISTANCE OF 2655.27 FROM THE NW COR SEC 29 TO THE W 1 4 COR SEC 29 IS 0.18' DIFFERENT THAN WPL'S GRID DISTANCE OF 2655.09, THE CI PROBABLY MONUMENTS THE LOCATION OF THE W 1 4 COR SEC 29 THAT WPL USED. SINCE THE CI IS IN HARMONY WITH RUGERS DISTANCES, OLD RECORD OCCUPATION, CLOSE TO THE DISTURBED LIMESTONE OF RECORD, AND LINE WITH THE PIPE FD AT W 1 1/16 COR OF THE SW 1 4 OF SEC 29, I AM ACCEPTING THE FD CI.

D) Describe any material discrepancy between the location of the corner as restored or reestablished and the location of that corner as previously restored or reestablished by distance and direction. Show the discrepancy on the plan view drawing under (a), above. Show the distances between the corner as previously restored or reestablished and (1) the corner as restored or reestablished, and (2) to at least 4 of the witness monuments shown on the drawing in (a), above.

BASED ON THE DIFFERENCE OF 0.23' BETWEEN THE MY DISTANCE AND RON COMB'S DISTANCE TO THE NW COR SEC 29 AND THE LOCATION OF THE TOP OF THE HORIZONTAL CI PIECE, I BELIEVE HIS LOCATION IS DIFFERENT THAN MINE. HIS LOCATION MAY BE THE EDGE OF THE TOP OF THE HORIZONTAL PIECE. BASED ON BELOW GROUND PHICAL EVIDENCE, I DON'T BELIEVE HE PLACED A PIN AS STATED IN HIS CSM. ALSO BASED ON THE RECORD DISTANCES, I BELIEVE THIS LOCATION IS NOT THE SAME AS SUNNY'S 1949 LOCATION. THE RECORD DISTANCES INDICATE HIS PIPE WOULD HAVE BEEN ABOUT 4' FARTHER SOUTH.
