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short of the recorded distance. Then established the S.E. Cor. of Smith & Bostwicks land taking the full short into account, designated on the plat point H. At this point the S.E. Cor. of the brick wall of Smith & Bostwicks store is  $\frac{3}{4}$  of an inch W. of their E. line that is the E. face of the brick wall at its S.E. Cor. is  $\frac{3}{4}$  of an inch W. of their E. line. Then measured from the point G. 206 ft. +  $11\frac{1}{2}$  inches to the point K. then drew the line G-H. it being Smith & Bostwicks E. line. The N.E. Cor. of the brick wall of the store point L is about  $2\frac{3}{4}$  inches W. of their E. line. That is the E. face of the brick wall at the N.E. Cor. is about  $2\frac{3}{4}$  inches W. of their E. line. The stone water table at the S.E. Cor. of Smith & Bostwicks brick store projects  $1\frac{1}{6}$  inches E. of the E. face of the brick wall. The stone foundation wall projects only  $1\frac{3}{6}$  inches E. of the E. face of the brick wall at the S.E. Cor. The W. face of the stone foundation wall projects 10 to  $10\frac{1}{2}$  inches W. of the W. face of the brick wall at the S.E. Cor. The red line on the plat indicates the E. line of Smith & Bostwicks land. Capt. Ed. E. Woodman and A. L. Cleveland assisted me in making the survey. Surveyed Jan. 30-1874

March 3rd 1875 Measured from the center of Peter Wells W. wall to the E. face of Smith & Bostwicks E. wall & found the distance to be 44 ft. and  $\frac{3}{4}$  of an inch. Measured the distance twice once with Mr. C. Smith & once with L. F. Patten.
