From the upper surface of the skew back, next to the wall, at the N.W. Cor. of the S. abutment of said highway bridge across Rock River, to the upper surface of large permanent stone monument located in Center Avenue, in line with the E. sides & Mid-way between the elm trees, near the S. W. Cor. of Claron St. & said Center Ave, said stone Monument was planted in the ground so that its upper surface was about five ft. below the ^{surface} ground. It is about 5 ft. long by 12 inches square, smoothly dressed on its upper surface, into which are cut the letters "D" "M". The upper surface of said monument is three feet two hundred & twenty five thousandths of a foot (3.225 ft.) above a horizontal plane Eight inches above the upper surface of the skew back, next to the wall, at the N. W. Cor. of the S. abutment of said highway bridge across Rock River at Monterey
