Found remains of old stake & hard lead stone at corner also found stumps of NW, SE, T, & remains of stumps of SE, BT, set hard lead stone 20x11x8 surrounded it with 4 hard lead stones

Set lead lead stone 21x10x7 surrounded it by 4 hard lead stones

Found old stake at corner also found stumps of SW, SE, E, & NW, NE, T, set irregular point of lead lead stone - point of lead stone surrounded it by 5 lead stones

Found post at corner also found stumps of NW, SE, T, set irregular hard lead stone 19x17x11/4 surrounded it by 4 lead lead stones

Found stumps of SW, SE, T, & SE, BT, set stone 22x7x6

Found stumps of SW, SE, T, & SE, BT had been del. set lead lead stone 12x7x5 surrounded it by 3 hard lead stones
