HIGHWAY DISTRICTS

At a meeting of the Commissioners of Highways of the Town of Beloit held on the 4th day of May 1842. The said town was divided in five road districts as follows:

District No. 1 - Shall include all that part of the Village of Beloit on the South side of a line through the center of Broad Street together with Sections 31, 32, 33, 34, 27. The East half of Section 28 in Town 1 Range 13 East and the East half of 36 in T. 1 R. 12 in said town.

District No. 2 - Shall include all that part of the Village of Beloit included in a line drawn through the center of Broad Street and a line drawn through the center of School Street together with Sections 29, 20, 21, 22, 15, 16, 10, the East half and the Southwest quarter of 30, and West half of 28 in town 1 Range 13 in said town.

District No. 3 - Shall include Sections 19, 18, 17, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and Northwest quarter of 30 in Town 1 Range 13 and all that part of Town 2, Range 13 contained in said town.
