Vacating Morgan & Coon St.

Whereas upon the application of six freeholders residing in said town of Milton for the discontinuing of two highways hereinafter described, we the undersigned Supervisors of said town did on the 8th day of January A.D. 1867 meet at the post office in West Milton in said town for the purpose of then and there deciding upon such application it being the time and place fixed by us for that purpose did proceed to examine personally such proposed highway having then and there heard such reasons as were offered for and against laying out the same did then and there decide upon such application and determined to lay out such highway as hereinafter described having as required by law first made out a notice and fixed therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application and the applicant for such highway having ten days previous to our said meeting caused such notice to be duly given to all the occupants of the lands through which said highway passes and such notice having also been posted up in the public places of the land through which said highways pass and such notice having also been posted up in three public places in said town ten days previous to the time of our said meetings. It is ordered and determined and we do hereby order and determine that said highway be and the same are hereby discontinued being discontinued follows; Morgan Street & Coys Street as appears from Morgan Plat of the addition to the village of West Milton in said town which runs from a highway on the quarter line of Section 28 in said town to Front Street in said town.

Whereas upon the application of six freeholders residing in said town of Milton for the laying out of a highway hereinafter described, we the undersigned supervisors of said town did on the 8th day of January A.D. 1867 meet at the post office at West Milton in said town for the purpose of then and there deciding upon such application it being the time and place fixed by us for that purpose did proceed to examine personally such proposed highway having then and there heard such reasons as were offered for and against laying out the same did then and there decide upon such application and determined to lay out such highway as hereinafter described having as required by law first made out a notice and fixed therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application and the applicant for such highway having ten days previous to our said meetings caused such notice to be duly given to all the occupants of the lands through which said highway passes and such notice having also been posted up in the public places ten days before the time of our said meeting it is ordered and determined and we do hereby order and determine that a highway be and the same is hereby laid out pursuant to said application where of an accurate survey has been made as follows to wit: Beginning in the West line of lot No. 94 in Morgans Plat of the Addition to the Village of West Milton in said town and 37 1/2 links South of the North line of said described lot; thence Easterly parallel with the North line of said lot to the West line of Front Street in said Plat the line of said survey to be the center of said highway and the same is established three rods in width the same being deemed sufficient by us.
