

ORDER NO. 4

OF HIGHWAY COMMISSIONER

FOR A ROAD THROUGH JOHN HACKETT

At a meeting of the Commissioners of Highways of the Town of Beloit holden at the dwelling house of John Hackett at one o'clock P.M. of the 21st day of April, 1845 for the purpose of consideration of the subject of the petition of John Hackett and others for the laying out of a highway. The Commissioners being satisfied that notices of this meeting having been posted up as the law requires, proceeded to examine the ground on the lines petitioned for, and caused a survey of the same to be made and do order that a line running West from the highway from Beloit to Janesville on the West side of Rock River being parallel with the quarter section line of Section 35 in Township 1 North of Range 12 East and 9.82 chains South of said quarter section line 35.03 chains to a point 80 rods East of the West line of said Section 35---and a line running North and South through the last mentioned point and parallel with the West line of said Section 35 extending from the South line of said section the last mentioned quarter line 40 chains be the center line of a highway of three rods in width.

The Commissioners of Highways for the Town of Beloit met at the house of Capt. Strong in said town this 31st day of April 1845 at ten o'clock A.M. to take into consideration the subject of the petition of J. W. Noggle and seven others for the laying out of a highway. When it was proved to the satisfaction of said Comm's. that notice of such meeting had been given as the law requires they proceeded to survey the ground on the route petitioned for, and as one of the Commissioners was not present, the decision of the subject was deferred to some subsequent meeting.

We the Commissioners of Highways for the Town of Beloit met at the house of J. G. Winslow in said town to take into consideration the subject of the petition of J. G. Winslow and others for the laying out of a highway this 6th day of October 1845, and after being satisfied that notice of this meeting has been given according to law, proceeded to survey the line petitioned for and do order that the same be the centerline of a highway of four rods in width running as follows: Beginning in a highway called the Pecatonica and Madison Road at the corners of Sections 19, 20, 30 & 29 in Township 1 North of Range 12 East; thence running East between Sections 20 and 29 one mile and East between Section 21 and 28 15/16 of a mile to the Territorial Road from Beloit to Madison.

And we further determine and order that a line surveyed by us, by petition of J. W. Noggle and others, on the 31st day April last be the centerline of a highway of four rods in width which runs thus: Beginning at an angle in an highway about 5 chains West of Goodhues flume in the Distillery dam.
thence running N. 70° W. 51 chains--thence N. 83° W. 26 chains; thence S. 57° W. 13 chains; thence S. 80° W. 60 chains; thence N. 74 1/2° W. 30 chains to sec. line; thence S. 87° W. 15 chains to 1/4 post S. side Sec. 29 T. 1 R. 11 same course to center S.W. 1/4 21 chains; thence N. 36° W. 51 chains; thence N. 21° W. 60 chains to road from Beloit to Sugar River.
