Whereas upon the application of six freeholders residing in said Town of Turtle for the laying out of a highway hereinafter described, we the undersigned supervisors of said town did meet at the house of Alonzo A. Allen of said town on Friday the 25th day of March, 1864 at ten o'clock A.M. for the purpose of examining the ground on the land petitioned to be laid out as a highway and we do hereby certify that upon being satisfied that notice of the time and place of this meeting had been given as the law requires, we proceeded to examine the line on the ground petitioned for, and have laid out a highway as hereinafter described as follows: Commencing on the highway running from Shopiere to the Milwaukee Road at a point 80 rods North of the South line of the Southeast quarter of Section 10 in said town of Turtle; thence running West, along the line between lands owned by John P. Fonda and Polly Allen 80 rods to lands owned by Alexander Allen and others; thence diagonally across lands owned by Alexander and William H. Allen to the center line between Sections 9 and 10; thence DUE WEST on the center of Section 9 through lands owned by Alexander Allen, the heirs of Abel F. Lewis and Albert A. Lewis to a highway leading from Hodson's Mills South to the Milwaukee Road on the center line of Section 9, therefore we the undersigned supervisors of the Town of Turtle hereby determine and declare the above described highway to be a public highway four rods in width.
