At a meeting of the Supervisors of said Town of Turtle on the 19th day of June, 1857 Ellek Bruce and H. J. Murry, Supervisors met agreeable to notice and examined and deliberated on the subject matter of this order. It is hereby ordered and determined by them that a highway be laid out in said town of the width of four rods commencing at a point where the highway known as the Janesville and Belvidere road crosses the North line of Section 26, Town 1 North of Range 13 East; thence running East on said line to within two-----of the center of the Northwest quarter of said Section 26; thence South, along on the West side of said center quarter line to a point where it intersects said original road near the South line of said quarter. And it is further ordered that the original road between said points is hereby vacated. Witness our hands this 29th day of June, 1857.

At a meeting of the Supervisors of said town of Turtle on the third day of April, 1858 two of the supervisors having met agreeable to notice and examined and deliberated on the subject matter of this order it is hereby ordered and determined by them that a highway be laid out in said town of the width of four rods commencing at the center of the South half of Section 34 and running directly South on said section line to the South line of the State of Wisconsin. The old angling road instead is hereby vacated.
