ORDER OF HIGHWAY COMMISSIONERS NUMBER FIVE

We the Commissioners of Highways for the Town of Newark met at the house of Washington Crasby in said Town on this 29th day of June A. D. 1846 at nine o'clock A. M. to take into consideration the subject of the Petition of Joseph Kinney Jun and seven others for the laying of a Highway when it was proved to be satisfaction of said Commissioners that such notice as the law requires had been given. We proceeded to survey the ground on the route petitioned for variation of the needle $6\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ Commencing in the Beloit and Sugar River Road at a point 4 chains from the quarter post on the North side of Section 24 Town 1 Range 10 - thence running South 59 degrees West 4 chains - thence West on the section line to the north west corner of Section 20 - thence South $61\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ West 18 chains - thence North $81\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ West 23 chains to the quarter post on the north side of Section 19 - thence West on the section line to the north West corner of Section 19 it being the west line of Rock County -

We order and determine that the above described line be the center line of a Highway of four rods in width
