The Supervisors of the Town of Turtle met on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of May A.D. 1853 at two o'clock of said day at the house of E. H. Treat to hear and determine upon the prayer of E.H. Treat, Joel Miner, Wm. Gates, Charles Randall, freeholders of said Town of Turtle for the discontinuance of certain roads therein named and laying out a certain other road therein named being first satisfied by evidence of E. Bradley and his return endorsed upon the notices that the notice required by Section 53, Chapter 16, Revised Statutes had been duly given and having duly examined such highways, it was by the said supervisors

Ordered That the road beginning at the Southeast corner of Section 14 and running West on the line between Sections 14 and 23 and 15 and 22 to the Milwaukee Road so called be and the same is hereby discontinued.

Ordered That the road beginning at a point 80 rods West of the Southeast corner of Section 15 and running North to the Milwaukee Road be and the same is hereby discontinued.

Ordered That a road commencing at the Southeast corner of Section 15 and running North between Sections 14 and 15, 160 rods crossing the Milwaukee Road be and the same is hereby laid out and established.

The further prayer of the petition for discontinuing the road from the Southeast quarter of Section 15 running East; thence to the Milwaukee Road near the Brick School House being opposed largely by a signed remonstrance by Hiram Warner and others was rejected.
