Southeast quarter of Section 31 in the Town of Plymouth 240 rods from the place of beginning, thence North 85 degrees East 53 rods and five feet, thence South 81 degrees East 28 rods and 12 feet to the Southwest corner of Section 32 in the Town of Plymouth, thence East on the Township line 2 miles and 148 rods to where the Beloit and Monroe Road crosses said township line, said courses and distances are to be the center of the road.

Variation of the magnetic needle $6\frac{1}{2}$ degrees East given under my hand this 28th day of January 1850

An agreement between the Supervisors of the Towns of Plymouth and Newark in relation to the above described highway - - It is hereby agreed between the Supervisors of the Towns of Newark and Plymouth that for road purposes the Town of Newark is to take the west part of the road laid out this day on the Town line to the West Branch of Coon Creek and Plymouth is to have the part East of the Creek and to build a bridge across the same.
