County Surveyor ORDER OF THE SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNS OF BELOIT AND NEWARK LAYING A HIGHWAY BETWEEN SAID TOWNS

At a joint meeting of the Supervisors of the towns of Newark and Beloit held according to notice on Tuesday 8th May 1849 (all the Supervisors being present) to take into consideration the subject embraced in this order it was determined by the said Supervisors that a highway be laid out in said towns of the width of four rods and the said Supervisors have caused a survey of the same to be made as follows.

The center line of said highway is to commmence at a point on the Madison and Beloit road thirty-six rods South of the Southwest corner of Section No. 6 Town 1 Range 12 East running thence due North one mile and thirty-six rods on the town line between Newark and Beloit to the Northwest corner of Section 6, Town 1 Range 12 East.

In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals this $8 \pm day$ of May 1849.
