ORDER FOR A HIGHWAY FROM BELOIT TO SUGAR RIVER

At a meeting of the Commissioners of Highways for the town of Beloit in the County of Rock and Territory of Wisconsin holden at the dwelling house of Hugh Lee in said Town on the first day of September A.D. 1843 two of said commissioners having met and deliberated on the Subject embraced in the following order: It is ordered and determined that a Highway be laid out in said town of the width of four rods leading from the Village of Beloit to Sugar River, said Highway is to pass through land not enclosed improved or cultivated, and the said Commissioners have caused a survey to be made, as follows: Commencing on the intersection Public Road leading in the Village of Beloit, at the end of the Bridge across Rock River, the Centerline runs north 30° West on the Center of said bridge and to a stake in a line with the South side of John Hackett's Stone Dwelling House 8 chains, thence N. 51° W. 4.50 chains, thence S. 89° W. 21.50 chains, thence N. 75° 45' W. 199.50 chains, thence N. 71° 30' W. 33 chains, thence due West 35 chains to Hickory Tree.
