Surveyed February 21st, 1848 for the Commissioners of Highways of the Town of Janesville, & Milton, Rock County, W.T.—an alteration of a road as follows:

Beginning at a point on the line between the aforesaid towns—where the old road leaves the said line between Sec. 3 and 34, West of J. Watterman's house. Now from said point as place of beginning running S. 84° 45' W. 99.75 on the town line to where the old Town Line Road intersects town line again, making one mile 29 rods. Also on same instant for the same commission. A road running from where the North and South road crosses the town line between Sec. 4 and 33, place of beginning. Run on the above described town line S. 45° 84° W. 108.50 to a post, thence N. 81° W. 55.0; thence S. 75° W. 6.80 to a post on town line, thence S. 84° 45' W. 44.45 on Town line to the Southwest corner of the Town of Milton.

The above described lines is the center of the roads, which is 66 feet wide.
