And now the Commissioners as aforesaid in and for said town do on the day and year first above written order and declare the moad as above described to be a public highway and we do further order the same to be opened as such pursuant to statute.

T. have this 24th day of May 1845 discontinued all that part of a certain highway or road in said town herein described, and generally known as the Madison Road: Beginning at the quarter section post on the North side of Sec. 35 in T. 3 N., R. 12 E. and running S. 67° 15' E. 73 ch. 31 links to a stump; thence N. 67° 30' E. 3 ch. 63 l. to the West end of the Janesville bridge. Variation of needle 8° E.

And now we the commissioners as aforesaid in and for said town do on the day and year first above written order and declare so much of said road as above described to be hereafter discontinued as a public highway pursuant to statute.
