We the Commissioners of Highways for the Town of Turtle hereby certify that on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of June A. D. 1846 at half past ten o'clock A.M. we all having been duly notified met at the house of Valentine Browns and found that notice of our meeting had been given as the law directs to wit:

Commencing at the quarter stake on the South side of Section 33, Town 2, Range 13 to run on the town line as follows: To run on the said line till it comes to the West side of said town and there intersect the road running from Janesville to Beloit.

Also at the same time and place, commencing at the Southwest corner of Section 33, Town 2 running North on the section line past Sinclair's; thence along said line till it strikes the North side of said town and there intersects a road running to Janesville.

We therefore on this 13<sup>th</sup> day of June A.D. 1846 do declare the above lines to be public highways. The roads to be six rods wide, 3 rods from the center line each way.
