Whereas a highway has been laid out by the supervisors of the Town of Janesville in the County of Rock from the East and West quarter line of Section 1, in said Town of Janesville; thence running West one mile to the center of the highway between Sections 1 and 2, in said town, which highway is more particularly described by an order of said supervisors bearing date the 19th day of December 1863 and which highway passes through and over lands of James Bear, Willard Corlew, Mrs. John Anderson, Samuel W. Blaker, Joseph Flagler, Mrs. Lydia W. Russell, C. D. Flagler, J. W. Russell and widow of J. C. Call. Now therefore it is hereby agreed between the said supervisors and the said James Bear that the damages sustained by said James Bear by reson of the laying out and opening of said highway be liquidated and agreed upon at \$18, to the said Willard Corlew the sume of
