We the Commissioners of Highways of the Town of Janesville, Rock County, Wisconsin Territory have this 10<sup>th</sup> day of January 1846 laid out and established a public highway in said town: Beginning at the Southeast corner of Section 21 in T. 3 N., R. 13 E. and running thence North on the East side of said Section, 8, 0 ch.; thence North on the East side of Section 16, 80 ch.; thence North on the East side of Section 9, 80 ch.; thence North on the East side of Sec. 4, 47 ch. 50 links to the center of the road leading from Janesville to Prairie Du Sac, all in township and range first named. Said road is laid three rods wide. Var. of Needle by coin with old survey. And now we the commissioners aforesaid in and for said town do on the day and year first above written, order and declare the road as above described to be a public highway and we do further order the same to be opened as such pursuant to statute.

And now we the Commissioners aforesaid in and for said town do on the day and year first above written, order and declare the road is above described to be
