## DIVISION OF A ROAD BETWEEN JANESVILLE AND ROCK

Janesville, May 21, 1847

We the undersigned Commissioners of Highways for the Towns Janesville and Rock this day have divided the town line road between the towns described as follows:

The Town of Janesville takes one mile and a half of the East end and one mile and 25 rods of the West end of said road.

The Town of Rock takes the remainder of said road, the whole distance of said road is five miles in length and was laid on the 15<sup>th</sup> day May 1847.

We the undersigned Commissioners of Highways for the Towns of Rock and Janesville did examine the ground and lay out a public highway on the line between T. 2 and 3, R. 12 E. called the Town Line road on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of May agreeably to the above draft beginning at the East corners of Sections 35 and 2; thence West on the town line to a stake 18 rods East of the West corner of Section 3, thence South 66° W. 18½ rods to a stake; thence S. 83° W. 8 rods to a stake; thence N. 80° W. 18½ rods to a stake on the line of said town; thence on said line to the West corner of T. 2 and 3, said road to be four rods wide two on each side of said line making by sections, a distance of five miles and on rod.
