We the Commissioners of Highways of the Town of Janesville, Rock County, W. T. have this 16<sup>th</sup> day June 1847 laid out and established a public highway in said town.

Beginning at the Southwest corner of Sec. 14, T. 2 N., R. 13 E. from thence North 8° 30' W. 160 ch. to the Northwest corner of Sec. 11 to a post and mound, all in the sections above mentioned.

Said road is laid four rods wide.

And now we the Commissioner aforesaid in and for said town, do on the day and year first above written, order and declare the road as above described to be a public highway and we do further order the same to be opened as such pursuant to statute.
