ORDER FOR DISCONTINUING HIGHWAY

Application having been made to the undersigned Supervisors of the Town of Newark by six freeholders of said town praying that the portion of a certain highway in said town described as follows: Commencing at the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 14 Town 1 Range 11 East running thence East on the quarter section line between the Southwest quarter and the Northwest quarter of said section one half of a mile be discontinued; said Supervisors met on the 17th of November A. D. 1860 at the house of James B. Shearman in said town; and proof of the fact that the notices required to be given of application to the Supervisors for the laying out altering or discontinuing of a highway as by the Revised Statutes Chap. 19 see 56 being made by the Statements of James B. Shearman and Hiram G. Atwood who declared that five days previous to the meeting personal notice that an application had been made to the Supervisors of the town aforesaid to discontinue that part of a highway in said town before described was given to the owners of land through which such highway passes; said persons being Abigail Miller, James B. Shearman and Hiram Atwood and that at least ten days previous to this meeting public notices were posted up in three public places in said town (one of said notices was put up at Doc't Millers corner, one at the Chase School house and one at the end of the road above described) Said notices accurately describing the road to be discontinued and the several tracts of land through which the same passes.
