Dec. 5, 1854

Recites---at a meeting of the Board of Supervisors of the Town of LaPrairie held at the house of Wm. Schenck in said town on the 5th day of December 1854 for the purpose of considering the petition of Amaziah Sherman and others for the discontinuing of a certain highway described as follows to wit: Commencing at the quarter stake on the section line between Sections 27 and 22 and running Northwest until it intersects the section line between Sections 21 and 22 and also to lay out and establish a highway described as follows to wit: Commencing at the corner stake on Section 15, 16,21 and 22 and running South on the section line between Sections 21 and 22 to the South line of said section; thence East on the section line between Sections 22 and 27 to the quarter stake of said Sections 22 and 27. It was resolved that the highway first above described be, and the same is hereby discontinued and the last above described highway be, and the same is hereby laid out and established four rods wide according to the Statutes of the State of Wisconsin in such cases made and provided.

Given under our hands this 5th day of Dec. 1854.

March 14, 1846

Recites in part---beginning at the quarter section post on the West side of Sec. 15, Town 2, Range 13 East; and running thence North 40 chains on the West side of said Sec. 15; thence North 80 chains on the West side of Sec. 10; thence North 40 chains on the West side of Sec. 3; thence North 1° 50', to the road leading from Janesville to Emerald Grove. Said road is four rods wide. And now we the Commissioners as aforesaid in and for said town do on the day and year first above written order and declare the road above described to be a public highway; and we further order the same to be opened as such pursuant to statute. Henry Green Comm. Hy's.
