February 21, 1863

Recites in part---it is ordered and determined and we do hereby order and determine that a highway be, and the same is hereby laid out pursuant to said application whereof an accurate survey has been made which is as follows to wit: Commencing at the quarter stake on the South line of Section 22; thence running North on said half section line, running by land occupied by Alman King and W. R. Winans of the East and George Weight and Henry Weight on the West of said line - the distance of 160 rods. The line of said survey is to be the center of said highway, and the same is established four rods in width.

Also in accordance with the aforesaid petition, we have surveyed the road therein described as follows: Commencing at the quarter stake between Section 22 and 27 running West one-half mile between lands owned by George Weight and D. E. Belding which was prayed to be discontinued or vacated. It is ordered and determined, and we do hereby order determine that the aforesaid described road be and the same is hereby vacated.

July 7, 1858

Recites in part---it is ordered and determined by the said supervisors that a highway be laid out in said town of the width of four rods and have caused a survey thereof to be made as follows: the center line of said highway is to commence at the Eastern boundary line of the City of Janesville in the center of the road running East by Levi St. Johns' house in Section 6; thence bearing South 86% East 38 chains and 78 links to the line between Section 5 and 6; thence the same course, two rods to the center of the North and South road; thence North one chain and 90 links; thence North 79° East 7 chains to a point near J. P. Wheeler's wind mill in the center of the Emerald Grove and Janesville road making the whole distance 48 chains and 15 links.

In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands at LaPrairie on the 7th day of July 1858.
