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Survey of a Road leading from Stones Ferry on Rock River to the East line of the Town of Janesville, made July 18 & 19, 1842.

Beginning at a point on the East bank of Rock River 5 chains and 75 links South of the North line of Section 30, T. 4 N., R. 12 E.; thence North 83° East 80 chains; thence North 65° East 63/4 chains to section line; thence East 41 chains; thence South 77° East one mile and 60 chains to a point which bears South from a Burr Oak tree 18 links; thence North 86 1/2° East 73 chains; thence South 86° East 22 chains; thence North 82 1/2 degrees East 40 chains; thence North 10 1/2 degrees East 10 chains; thence North 33 1/2° East 9 chains to a point on the North line of Section 25, 17 chains and 30 links West of the quarter post; thence East 57 chains and 30 links to the Northeast corner of Section 25; and the whole length of the road is five miles, 79 chains and 5 links.
