ROAD ORDER OF SUPERVISORS OF DIVIDING Extension 237
ROAD BETWEEN ROAD DISTRICTS NO. T.O AND THREE

AND THREE AND FOUR

We the undersigned Supervisors of the Town of Newark at a meeting held by us in said town did after due deliberation order and determine that the highway running East and West on the section line between Sections 9 and 4 in said town one mile in length between Road Districts No. 2 and 3 shall be divided between said districts as follows to wit.

Road District No. 2 shall repair and keep in repair the West one half of said highway and have the Supervision of the same and Road District No. 3 shall repair keep in repair and have the supervision

of the East one half of said highway.

And also that the highway running North and South between Road District No. 3 and 4 between Sections 9 and 10 be divided as follows to wit. 80 rods of the North end of said highway shall be kept in repair by Road District No. 4 and the 80 rods next South shall be kept in repair by Road District No. 3 and we do further order that the balance of the said highway on the East side of District No. 3 being 80 rods in length to git the South one third of such highway shall worked and kept in order by Road District No. 18.
