ORDER OF HIGHWAY COMMISSIONERS NUMBER FOUR

We the Commissioners of Highways for the Town of Newark met at the house of William Crippen in said Town on the 15th day of May A.D. 1846 at ten o'clock A. M. to take into consideration the subject of the Petition of Nelson Kinney and twelve others for an alteration of the Beloit and Sugar River Road where it was proved to the satisfaction of said Commissioners that notice of such meeting had been given as the law requires they proceeded to survey the ground on the Route petitioned for and as one of the Commissioners was not present the decisions of the subject was deferred to some subsequent meeting --

On the 23rd day of September A.D. 1846 at the house of Zebulon Sargent we further order and determine that a line surveyed by us on the Petition of Nelson Kinney and 12 others on the 15th day of May last be the center line of a Highway of four rods in width which runs thus: Commencing at the quarter section post on the South side of Section ten Town 1 Range 10 - thence running West on the section line 20 chains - thence North $66\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ West 21 chains 90 links - variation of the needle $6\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ - thence North $72\text{-}\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ West 21 chains 89 links - thence South 69° West 25 chains and 72 links - thence North 62° West 17 chains - thence North $66\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ West 47 chains and 87 links - thence North $61\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ West 76 chains - thence North $70\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ West 6 chains and 20 links - thence North $78\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ West 20 chains - thence North $74\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ West 23 chains - and 14 links - thence North $59\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ West 24 chains to wherethe County line was supposed to be.
