T. have this 25th day of May 1846 laid out and established a public highway in said town from a post in Sec. 36, T. 3 N., R. 12 E. standing in the Beloit Road and running S. 41° 45' E. 3 ch. 66 l. to township line; thence 1 ch. 66 l. same course; thence S. 36° E. 9 ch. 50 l.; thence S. 24° E. 19 ch. 50 l.; thence S. 84° E. 10 ch. 50 l. along a line two rods distant from St. John's _____; thence S. 86° 10' E. 65 ch. 50 l.; thence S. 77' E. 18 ch.; thence S. 73° 15' E. 15 ch. 10 l. thence S. 81° E. 46 ch. 50 l. to line between North and South half of Sec. 4, T. 2 N., R. 13 E.; thence East 55 ch. 40 l. to the quarter post on the East side of said Sec. 4; thence East on line between the North and South half of Sec. 3, 6 ch. 10 l. to the center of the track leading to Emerald Grove; thence Easterly 2 miles 75 ch. 10 l. same course described in the return of a road recording in the Town Clerk's office and laid out on the 24th day of March 1846 said course being the last one given in the return referred to said road extends two rods on each side of the line described, variation of Needle 7° 30' E. and now we the Commissioners aforesaid, in and for said town, do on the day and year first above written, order and declare the road as above described to be a public highway, and we do further order the same to be opened as such pursuant to statute.
