Station first in the Town of Janesville commencing six chains North of the Southwest corner of Sec. 19 of T. 3 N., R. 12 E. running East 5° 30' S. 11 ch. until it strikes the section line; thence running with said line to the Southeast corner of maid section, adopting a road previously laid out and located running from Madison to Janesville.
