We the Commissioners of Highways of the Town of Janesville, Rock County, W.T. have the 2nd day of May 1846 altered a part of the territorial road in said town leading from Madison to Big Foot Prairie as follows: Beginning at the angle in said roads 3 chains East of the quarter section post between Sec. 23 and 26 in T. 3 N., R. 13 E. and running West between said sections to a point 49 rods East of the Northeast corner of said Sec. 26; thence N. 61° W. one mile and 2 chains to where said territorial road crosses the line between the East and West half of the Southwest quarter of Sec. 22, same town and range, and to the center thereof, said alteration to be of the same width of said Territorial road, variation of needle 7° 30' E.

And now we the Commissioners of Highways aforesaid in and for said town do on the day and year first above written, order and declare the alteration of said road as above described, to be a public highway, and a part of said territorial road, and we do further order the same to be opened as such pursuant to statute.

We the Commissioners of Highways of the Town of Janesville, Rock County, W. T. have this the 22nd day of August 1846 altered a part of a road in said town, leading East and Southeast from near John P. Dickson's house, to township line, as follows: Beginning two rods West of the Northwest corner of Sec. 4, T. 2 N., R. 13 E. from thence South 52° East, 57 chains 25 links to the center of said Sec. 4, thence intersecting the road leading from Janesville, by way of L. St. John's and L. T. Wheeler's, to Emerald Grove said alteration to be four rods wide.

And now we the commissioners of Highways aforesaid in and for said town do on the day and year first above written, order and declare the alteration of said road as above described, to be a public highway, and we do further order the same to be opened pursuant to statute.
