Whereas upon the application of six freeholders residing in said town of Janesville for the laying out of a highway hereinafter described. We the undersigned supervisors of said town did on the 19th day of December A.D. 1863 meet at the house of S. W. Blaker on said town for the purpose of then and there deciding upon such application being the time and place fixed by us for that purpose did proceed to examine personally such highway and having then and there heard such reasons as were offered for and against laying out the same. Did then and there decide upon such application and determine to lay out such highway as hereinafter described. Having as require by law first made out a notice and fixed therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application and the applicant for such highway having five days previous to our said meeting caused such notice to be duly given to all the occupants of the lands through which said highway passes, and such notice having also been posted up in three public places in said town ten days before said time of our said meeting. It is ordered and determined that a highway be and the same is hereby laid out pursuant to said application whereof an accurate survey has been made which is as follows: Commencing in the center of the highway between the Towns of Janesville and Harmony and on the East and West quarter line of Section 1 in said town of Janesville; thence running West one mile to the center of the highway between Sections 1 and 2 in the Town of Janesville aforesaid. The line of said survey to be the center of said highway. And the same is established four rods in width.

In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands this 19th day of December A.D. 1863.
