We the Supervisors of the Towns of Janesville and Fulton, Rock County, Wisconsin do certify upon the application of six or more freeholders of said towns for the laying out of a public highway in Towns of Janesville and Fulton as follows to wit:

"Commencing from the quarter post of Sec. 4 on Town line of Fulton and Janesville running N. 82% East 79 chains 22 links."

That we caused notices to be posted up in writing in three of the most public places in said Towns of Fulton and Janesville, specifying the road above named purposed for highway, and the time and place at which we would meet to make examination of the same, which notices were posted at least ten days before said meeting, and we do further certify that being fully satisfied that the notices required by law had been given pursuant to statute; we on this 20m day of October 1851 it being the specified time in said notice, met at the hour and place named therein, examined and caused survey to be made of the said proposed highway. Heard all reasons for and against laying out the same, we are of opinion that said highway is necessary and proper and proceeded to lay out the same.

And now we the supervisors aforesaid in and for the Towns of Janesville and Fulton do on this 20th day of October A.D. 1851 order and declare the above described road to be a public highway, four

rods wide.

And we do further order the same to be kept open as such pursuant to statute. And we do further certify that we have assessed the damages as follows to wit:

To Wm. W. Key \$30 dollars damages
Geo. R. Ramsey \$40 " "

Jos. Caldwell \$10 " "

to be paid equally by both towns, Town of Fulton to pay G. R. Ramsy \$40 and the Town of Janesville.
