Whereas upon the application of more than six freeholders residing in the Town of Janesville for the laying out of a highway

as hereinafter described.

We the undersigned supervisors of said town did on the 9th day of December A.D. 1871 make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application and did meet on the 20th day of December A.D. 1871 at two o'clock in the afternoon of said day at the house of J. H. Carle in said town it being the time and place fixed by us in said notice and having first been satisfied that legal notice had been given to the owners of the land through which the highway passes and also had been posted up in three public places in said town ten days before time of our meeting in the manner required by law. We did then and there proceed to examine personally said highway and did hear all the reasons that were offered for or against laying out the same and it being our opinion that the public road or good will thereby be promoted did decide to lay out said highway as hereinafter described.
