That we the supervisors of the Town of Janesville aforesaid having caused notices to be set up in three public places in said town that we would meet on the said 8th day of December at L. P. Stannord for the purpose of viewing said route and surveying the same.

The said supervisors meet agreeable to such notice and after becoming satisified that such notices were duly posted up at three of the public places in said town at least ten days previous to said 8th day of December and that a copy of such notices were served on the persons over whose lands said proposed highway runs to wit: John Little, Robert W. Horn, William Mills, James Cleland, William Newett and Ann Newett at least six days previous to the said meeting of said supervisors and after hearing reasons for and against the laying out of said proposed highway we proceeded to view the said route and it appearing to us to be necessary for the public good that the same be established as a highway. Now we the said supervisors do order and determine that a public highway be and the same is hereby laid out, surveyed and established as a public highway of the width of four rods, two rods on each side of the center line which is described as follows to wit: Beginning in the public highway leading from Janesville to the Village of Albany and at the Northeast corner of the Northwest quarter of Section 29, and running from thence South on the quarter section line to the Southeast corner of the Southwest quarter of said Section 29, and to the road commonly called "Middle Road" and we do hereby order the same to be opened for the width of four rods, for public travel and in pursuance to statute.
