We the undersigned Supervisors of the Town of Janesville in the County of Rock having by an order bearing date the 4th day of December A.D. 1858 upon due application for that purpose laid out a highway as follows: The center line of said highway is to commence at a point two rods West of the Northeast corner of Section 32. Town 3 North, Range 12 East and in the center of the road called Middle Road running thence South in a line parallel with the section line between Sections 32 and 33, T. 3 N., R. 12 East to the center of the Galena Road (so called) and to a point two rods West of the Southeast corner of the Northeast quarter of said Section 32 and certain owners of lands through which said highway is laid out to wit: Guy Reed not having released all claims to damages sustained by reason of the laying out and opening said highway and not being able to agree with him as to the amount of such damages having applied to him for that purpose and endeavored to make such agreement we did proceed and assess the damages which such owner would sustain by reason of the laying out such highway through his lands as follows: To Guy Reed on the North half of the Northeast quarter of Section 32, town and range aforesaid, we have awarded the sum of one hundred and sixty dollars as damages to said lands.
