SURVEY BILL TO ORDER NUMBER EIGHT

This day surveyed by direction of the supervisors of the Town of Newark the following described road to wit.

Beginning on the highway at the West gate on the Southwest side of C. F. H. Goodhues Pond, thence running south 83 degrees West 14 rods and 7 feet, thence north 36 degrees West 30 rods and five feet - thence north 89 degrees West 104 rods and 4 feet, thence West to a stake 2 rods North of the East end of Benjamin Knapp's sod fence, thence Westerly running parallel with said fence, thence westerly, south side of Gurden Lacketts sod fence to the northwest corner of Section 34, thence West on the section line between Section 38 and Section 33 to the section corner of said Section 28 and 33, said corners and distances are the center of the road, Variation of the magnetic needle 6 degrees E.

ROAD ORDER OF SUPERVISORS NUMBER NINE

At a meeting of the Supervisors of the Town of Newark, held at the house of Mr. George Smith, on the 30th day of June 1849, to take into consideration the subject embraced in the annexed petition it was ordered and determined after a survey of the proposed road that a public highway be laid out, described as follows. Commencing at the South West corner of George Smith's land, running north until it intersects a road running East and West, crossing Goodhue's dam - - Width of said road four rods
