Whereas upon the application of six freeholders residing in said town of Turtle for the discontinuing of a highway hereinafter described; we the undersigned supervisors of said town did on the 4th day of January A.Di 1861 meet at the house of J. A. Harris in said town for the purpose of then and there deciding upon such application, it being the time and place fixed by us for that purpose did proceed to examine personally such highway and having then and there heard such reasons as were offered for and against discontinuing the same, did then and there decide upon such application and determined to discontinue said highway as hereinafter described; having as required by law first made out a notice and fixed therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application and the applicant for such discontinuance having five days previous to our said meeting caused such notice to be duly given to all the occupants of the land through which said highway passes and such notice having also been posted up in three public places in said town ten days before the time of our said meetings, it is ordered and determined and we do here by order and determine that said highway be and the same is hereby vacated pursuant to said application as follows:

Commencing at a point 80 rods East of the quarter stake between Sections 1 and 12, Town 1, Range 13 East; thence South 62% East 22 chains and 38 links to the line of the Town of Clinton at a point 9.70 chains South from the Northeast corner of Section 12, Town 1, Range 13 East according to a survey made and signed being in Turtle and recorded in the Book of Records in the Town of Turtle on the 25th day of September 1848 the line of said survey being center of said highway and the same is discontinued four rods in width.

In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands this 4m day of January A.D. 1861.
