ROAD ORDER OF SUPERVISORS NUMBER LIGHT

Between 28 and 33

At a meeting of the supervisors of the Town of Newark held at the house of Mr. Morgan on the 29th day of September 1849 to take into consideration the matter embraced in the annexed petition it was ordered and determined that a public highway of the wiath of four rods be laid out in said Town, Described as follows - - -

The center of said Highway shall commence at the north mile and one quarter, thence following the sod fence on the section line 40 rods leaving said fence on the south side of said road - thence running 40 rods until it intersects a point described in the commencement of the annexed survey bill - - running thence as described in the survey bill annexed - - - -

It is further ordered by the said Commissioners that a road commencing at the dam of C. F. H. Goodhue and running through the lands of C. F. H. Goodhue next through the land of John Jinnings, thence G. F. Hackett - thence through the land of Woodard, Reep, and other until it intersects the road running on the north line of Section 32 - is hereby discontinued
