At a meeting of the Supervisors of the Town of Newark held pursuant to notice, at the house John L. R. Thomas in said town in consequence of a petition for a highway in said town and it appearing to the satisfaction of the undersigned that all the notice by law required to be given, had been given. It was ordered and determined, that a public highway of the wiath of four rods, be laid out and established in said town described as follows, Commencing at a point where the Beloit and Madison road strikes the section line between sections one and two in said town of Newark, near the house of Peter Kithline, running thence in a northwesterly direction, in accordance with the annexed survey of Peter McVean County Surveyor until said road shall intersect a road lately laid out in the town of Plymouth and terminating near the quarter post of section two on the Town line agreeable to the survey bill annexed.
