Page 60 of Record (Oakhill Avenue - Award) September 7, 1867

Recites——whereas a highway has been laid out by the supervisors of the Town of Rock in the County of Rock—commencing at the center quarter post of Section 2 in said town running from thence South through the center of Sections 2 and 11 and 14 to the North line of Section 23 to a public highway running East and West, all in Town 2, Range 12 East. Which highway is more particularly described by an order of said supervisors bearing date the 28th day of June 1852 and described as follows:

Commencing at the Northwest corner of the North half of the Northeast quarter of Section 14 of said Town of Rock; thence South 80 rods to the Southwest corner of same North half of the N.W.% of Section 14.

Now therefore it is hereby agreed between the said supervisors and the said Thomas Beskick that the damages sustained by the said Thomas Beskick because of the laying out and opening said highway upon his said lands be liquidated and agree on
