At a meeting of the Supervisors of said town agreeable to previous notice and having examined and deliberated upon the subject herein embraced it is ordered and determined by the said Supervisors that a highway be laid out in said Town of Janesville of the width of four rods and have caused a survey thereof to be made as follows: The center line of said highway is to commende. at a point two rods West of the Northwest corner of Section 16, Town 3 North of Range 12 East and in the center of the highway leading from Janesville to Madison (called Madison Poad) and to run thence South parallel with the section line between Section 16 % 17 to the quarter line between the Northeast quarter and the Southeast quarter of Section 17 and to a point two rods West of the Southeast corner of the Mortheast quarter of said Section 17, thence South 5° 45' East five chains to the section line between said Section 16 and 17; thence South on said section line to the Southeast corner of said Section 17; thence South on the section line between Section 20 and 21 and range aforesaid to the Southeast corner of said Section 20 and to the center of the Magnolia Road (so called). Var. of the needle 8° East.

And now therfore we the supervisors aforesaid in and for the flown of Janesville aforesaid do on this 15th day of March 1858 order and declare the above described road to be a public highway and we do further order the same to be opened and kept open as such pursuant to statute.
