We the undersigned supervisors of the Town of Janesville in the County of Rock having by an order bearing the date the 12<sup>th</sup> day of January A.D. 1859 upon due application for that purpose laid out a highway as follows: The center line of said highway is to commence at a point in the center of the highway leading from the City of Janesville to the Village of Albany and at the Northeast corner of the Northwest quarter of Section 29, Town 3 North, Range 12 East running thence South on the quarter section line to the Southeast corner of the Southwest quarter of said Section 29, town and range aforesaid, and to the center of the road commonly called Middle Road and certain owners of land through which said highway is laid out to wit: Robert W. Horn, Wm. Newett, Ann Newett, James Cleland, not having released all claims to damages sustained by reason of the laying out and opening said highway and not being able to agree with them as to the amount of such damages. Having applied to them for that purpose and endeavored to make such agreement. We did proceed and assess the damages which such owners would sustain by reason of the laying out such highway through their lands as follows:

To Robt. W. Horne, on the East half of the Southwest quarter of said Section 29, town and range aforesaid, we have awarded the sum of \$75 as damages to said land. and to Wm. Newett and Ann Newett on the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of said section 29, we have awarded the sum of \$37.50 as damages to said land. And to James Cleland on the Southeast quarter of the North east quarter of said Section 29, we have awarded the sum of \$1 as damages to said lands.
