We the supervisors of the Town of Janesville, Rock County, Wisconsin do certify that on the application of six or more freeholders of said town asking for a laying out and opening certain lots into public highway in the Town of Janesville as follows:

To wit: "To continue Bluff Street from High Street to Jackson Street running over lots 148 and part of 87 in Smith, Bailey and Stone's Addition to the Village of Janesville."

That we caused notices to be posted up in three of the most public place in said town of Janesville specifying the streets above named proposed for highways, and the time and place we would meet to make examination of the same. Which notices were posted up at least ten days before said meeting, and we do further certify that being fully satisfied that the notices required by law
