That we caused notices to be posted up in writing in three of the most public places in said Town of Janesville, specifying the streets above named proposed for highways; and the time and place at which we would meet to make examination of the same, which notices we posted up at least two days before said meeting.

And we do further certify that being fully satisfied that the notices required by law have been given pursuant to statute.

We on this 26<sup>th</sup> day of March 1850 it being the specified time in said notices met at the hour and place therein named examined said streets proposed for highways, heard all the reasons offered for or against laying out the same. we are of the opinion that such highways were necessary and proper, and proceeded to lay out the same,

And now we the Commissioners aforesaid, in and for the said town do on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of March A.D. 1850 order and declare the above described streets to be public highways, and we do further order the same to be kept open as such pursuant to statute.
