We the undersigned supervisors of the Town of Janesville, Rock County, Wisconsin do certify that on the application of six or more freeholders of said town asking for the laying out of certain streets in the Town of Janesville into public highway as follows:

To wit: "Bluff Street running through the Village of Janesville. Hickory, Glenn, Pixley and Shaw's Addition, Division Street, Wisconsin and East Street in the Village of Janesville, and all the streets intersecting said streets East and West of the River through the Village of Janesville according to the recorded plats of the same.

That we caused notices to be posted up in three of the most public places in said town of Janesville specifying the streets above named proposed for highways, and the time and place we would meet to make examination of the same which notices were posted up at least ten days before said meeting and we do further certify that the notices required to by law had been given pursuant to statute. We on this 28th day of February A.D. 1853 it being the specified time in said notices met at the hour and place therein named and examined said streets pruposed for highway, heard all the reasons for and against laying out the same, we are of opinion that such highways are necessary and proper and proceeded to lay out the same. And now we the supervisors in and for the Town of Janesville do on this 28th day of February A.D. 1853 order and declare the above described land or streets to be public highways, and we do further order the same to be kept open as such pursuant to statute.
