We the undersigned Commissioners of Highways of the Town of Janesville, Rock County, Wisconsin have this 24th day of June, 1848 laid out and established a public highway in said town.

Beginning at the West end of the new or lower bridge in the Village of Janesville; thence running the whole length of Pleasant Street to the intersection with Madison Street as recorded in the town plat of Smith, Bailey and Stone's Addition and Palmer and Sutherland's Addition to Janesville. Said road is be four rods wide.

And now we the Commissioners aforesaid in and for said town do on the day and year fist above written, order and declare the road above described to be a public highway and we do further order the same to be opened as such pursuant to statute.
